YOUTH INVASION SPECIAL WAIVER (applicable to participants under 18)

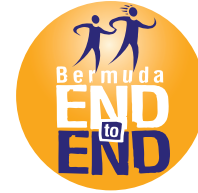
By signing, I, as parent or guardian, confirm this participant is over the age of 14 and they know where to reach a parent, guardian or responsible adult who has agreed to collect them in case they are unable to complete the route or that they are under the age of 14 and will be accompanied by a parent, guardian or responsible adult during the event. I understand the requirements of this waiver and as parent or guardian I have signed to show my agreement for the person's participation in this sponsored event. I understand there will be accessible telephones at all water stops.

FOR CYCLISTS

In consideration of my child's participation in the Bermuda End-to-End or Middle-to-End Bike Ride I agree: to wear an ANSI or SNELL approved helmet that fits and is clipped up while I am riding the bicycle during the ride, to abide by the Highway Code (The Road Traffic Act 1947) at all times. I acknowledge that the ride requires me/my child to be capable of controlling a pedal cycle on open roads with traffic and other cyclists and that I further acknowledge that this ride requires me/my child to be in good physical condition. I understand that my/ my child's participation in this ride carries a risk of personal injury which maybe caused by terrain, weather conditions, my/my child's physical condition, vehicular and pedestrian traffic and participants and volunteers in this ride. I am of legal age and understand this consent and release.

FOR PADDLERS/ROWERS/SWIMMERS/DIVERS/EQUESTRIANS

The Overall Person In Charge (OIC) has final call on the capabilities of paddlers/rowers/swimmers/divers and equestrians to enter as well as weather cancellation. All paddlers and rowers must wear life vests. Paddlers/rowers should be in groups of at least two, start together and finish together. Divers participate in a buddy system. All paddlers and rowers must know a capsized drill and how to effect a rescue. All participants in these four categories should be of reasonable standard/ability.
