- Car - Parking in Dockyard is restricted. Please use public transportation whenever possible or park in Mailbox Field.
- Bus: Hamilton to St. George's bus leaves at 6:15am. Main Terminal Ferry: XL Catlin End-to-End participants ride free on all ferries during regular service throughout event day, on showing their number tag.
- Ferry departure times as published by Sea Express. Capacity of ferries is 350 persons maximum.
- ETE Cyclists: NEW FERRY DEPARTURE and EVENT START TIMES. Ferry departs Hamilton at 7:30am for the 3am New Start Time. Tickets are available at registration and, as space is limited, tickets are on a first come, first served basis.
