· Follow South Shore, to Paynter's Road, Harrington Sound Road, across the causeway, to Penno's Wharf -St. George's and return. Enter Main gate, Botanical Gardens

Botanical Gardens to Devils Hole - Return, 10.8 miles From South Shore Road gate, Botanical

Gardens. Follow South Road. left on Devils Hole Road. Harrington Sound Road, right on Paynter's Road, South Road to Botanical Gardens. Enter Main gate, Botanical Gardens

Royal Naval Dockyard to St. George's to Botanical Gardens

. From Clocktower entrance

· Follow South Road to Penno's Wharf /St. George's, · return Harrington Sound Road to Devils Hole Road, left to South Road. Enter Main gate, Botanical Gardens
