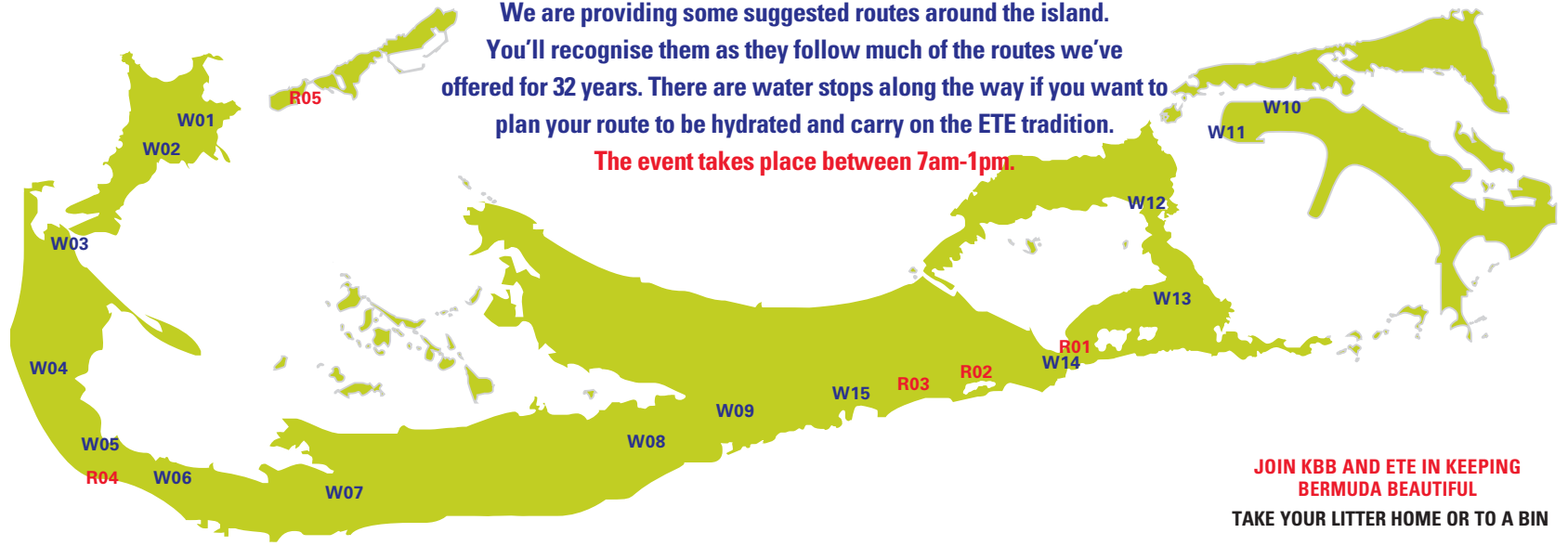


We are providing some suggested routes around the island. You'll recognise them as they follow much of the routes we've offered for 32 years. There are water stops along the way if you want to plan your route to be hydrated and carry on the ETE tradition.

Please note the locations of our water stops. Plan your own walk or cycle to take advantage of these stops if they happen to match your self-designed route. **There is no start or finish line this year.**

**Suggested Routes**

- WALKS**
  - St. George's to Botanical Gardens**, 10.2 miles  
**From the St. George's Town Square** Turn left onto Paynter's Road and follow South Road to the East Entrance at Botanical Gardens
  - Royal Naval Dockyard to Botanical Gardens**, 13.5 miles  
**From Clocktower entrance** Follow Rail Trail to South Road to the East Entrance at Botanical Gardens
  - Fun Walk**, 4.5 miles  
**From John Smith's Bay to Botanical Gardens** Follow South Road to the East Entrance at Botanical Gardens
- CYCLING**
  - Botanical Gardens to St. George's - Return**, 20.4 miles  
**From South Shore Road gate, Botanical Gardens**  
 Follow South Shore, to Paynter's Road, Harrington Sound Road, across the causeway, to Penno's Wharf - St. George's and return. Enter Main gate, Botanical Gardens
  - Botanical Gardens to Devils Hole - Return**, 10.8 miles  
**From South Shore Road gate, Botanical Gardens**, Follow South Road, left on Devils Hole Road, Harrington Sound Road, right on Paynter's Road, South Road to Botanical Gardens. Enter Main gate, Botanical Gardens
  - Royal Naval Dockyard to St. George's to Botanical Gardens**  
**From Clocktower entrance**  
 Follow South Road to Penno's Wharf /St. George's, return Harrington Sound Road to Devils Hole Road, left to South Road. Enter Main gate, Botanical Gardens

**Important Information**

- Event number must be displayed at all times during the event in order to receive participant extras.
- Fun Walk/Cycle is the appropriate event for young participants.
- All children who participate must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Event water stops will fill the reusable bottle given with the registration goodie bag - **no drink cups will be available.**

- There will be an event office in the Jack King Building in the Botanical Gardens for drive-through collection of event #, t-shirt, water bottle, goody bag, flip flops and finish medal. This office is open October 21, 22 and 23 from 8am-6pm.

**Safety Tips for Participants**

- Hand sanitizer will be available at each water stop
- Please practice social distancing at all times
- Wear your mask at water stops
- Please take your water bottle. Water stops will administer water with extra precautions. **No cups.** Water stops are able to provide aspirin, band-aids some simple first aid items to you. Or, call 911 for assistance.
- Wear good walking shoes
- Cycle helmets are mandatory
